- Several equipment was purchased under the AHEAD Project in 2021.
















Outreach Activities/ Programs Conducted by the Faculty Staff






Outcomes of Research studies in 2021

• Dr. (Mrs.) R. F. Niranjana, Senior Lecturer Gr. I, Department of Agricultural Biology found that application of 1% (w/v) *Piper longum* and *Acorus calamus* extracts reduce the *Callosobruchus maculatus* infection in green gram.



• Dr. R. Eeswaran and his co-authors at Michigan State University has shown that no-till agriculture could improve the overall resilience in a corn-soybean-wheat rotation at a watershed scale. Access the publication here: https://doi.org/10.1016/j.agee.2021.107612



• Mrs. Nishanthi Vathshalyan, Lecturer (Prob), Department of Agricultural Biology conducted a survey on banana anthracnose disease intensity in major fruit stalls in Ninthavur divisional secretariat of Ampara district and revealed that the anthracnose disease was prevalent in the study area in all assessed varieties. However, intensity varied depending on the handling practices and the varietal differences. Further, variety 'Puli Kathali' was more susceptible to anthracnose disease when they physically damaged. Also, the disease intensity of varieties 'Puli kathali', 'Seeni Kathali' and 'Kolikkoodu' were lesser than the disease intensity of variety 'Etharai' regardless to the handling practices adopted by the fruit sellers.
